The Willingdon Trees Neighbourhood Panel, in conjunction with Eastbourne Borough Council, Sussex Police, Eastbourne Homes and Places for People, have come together to address neighbourhood priorities and concerns on the Willingdon Trees Estate, in a community clear up.

We will be addressing issues identified by the community ranging from speeding cars, anti-social behaviour, street cleansing, fly-tipping, graffiti, bad parking, untaxed and uninsured vehicles, and more. We are looking for community minded residents to assist in a litter pick-up on the 20th of May if you are interested in helping, please come along to the Community Centre at 10.00am.

There will be a kerbside rubbish collection, on Saturday, 16th May from 7am to 9:45am for general waste and larger items will be collected on Wednesday, 20th May and Thursday, 21st May from 9am to 3pm. We will collect all rubbish with the **exception of chemicals, paint and green waste**. Please attend one of the street meetings if you require an assisted collection.

The Community Enforcement Team from Eastbourne Borough Council will be carrying out patrols from 16th May to 21st May. The team are able to deal with dog fouling, fly-posting, fly-tipping, graffiti, litter issues and overhanging vegetation.

We will be conducting speed checks, addressing parking issues, conducting high visibility patrols and tackling anti-social behaviour.
