Apologies were received from Viv Strudwick.

Cold Calling- The problem of cold calling was discussed. It is hoped to make the local area a cold calling zone. There are costs involved and this needs to be researched.

Cars being sold 'off the street'- Cars are being parked in residential areas in order to be offered for sale. This blocks up spaces, making it difficult for residents to park near their own homes. It is illegal and there are penalties in place to prevent it.

Horsey Sewer- The area is still an eyesore and the problem was discussed. Councillor Tutt kindly offered to approach the owners and discuss solutions.

Moy Avenue Traffic Problems- Cllr Tutt advised us that There is a Borough wide order prohibiting vehicles over 5 tonnes from parking on the highway between 6pm and 6am. Any fleet vehicle over 3.5 tonnes is prohibited from parking overnight unless at a licensed operating centre. Due to the recent severe weather, there have been a number of areas of road with deep puddles. Passing cars can splash up a lot of water, soaking pedestrians. We were advised that we can take number plates or photos of cars driving in an inconsiderate manner and pass them to the police.

The Path from Churchdale Road to Hammonds Drive- It has been discovered that this land belongs to the Environment Agency, Sussex Police and Eastbourne Council between them.

The Tip- The nuisance of business people taking items into the tip by hand to avoid paying for disposal was discussed along with fly tipping outside the entrance. If they are seen, please take car numberplates to enable matters to be taken further.

Car Park at Bridgemere Centre- There isn't much that can be done about this as placing a gate or blocking the path would require planning permission. Police patrols have been increased in the area but no one has been seen.

Parking outside local schools- This is a continual problem and will continue to be addressed by contact with the schools and public education. A day of action is being planned, and will hopefully help the situation. It is possible that ESK may allow parents to park in their car park. A great help!

Dog Mess- There is still a problem with dogs mess in the area. There are plain clothes dog wardens that issue warnings and penalties. Wendy has put an article in the press . We were asked that if we see dog walkers leaving their pets mess, to note a description and let the dog wardens know. Wendy has posters that will soon be on display.
