Issues discussed

- Speeding vehicles in Foxglove Road.
- Re-launch of Neighbourhood Panel in 2011
Further to the recent Quality Street Meeting in Milfoil Drive and the local operation that followed approx 20 residents have expressed an interest in joining the local Neighbourhood Panel. We have struggled in the past to persuade the community to get involved and this is a real opportunity to establish an effective panel in the Shinewater area.
- Nominate a new Chairperson.
Unfortunately, the current Chair has been unable to attend several meetings. For the Panel to succeed there needs to be a reliable Chairperson. Sgt Ripley proposed that the current chair should step down and take up the role of Vice Chair. He understood that the current Chair was involved with a number of organisations and therefore, it would be difficult to fully commit to this role. The Panel agreed that a new chair should be nominated at the next Panel Meeting which will be held in the new year.

- LR reported speeding vehicles in Foxglove Road. She asked for 'Slow down' signs to be put up in the area. Sgt R to action.
- LR reported her concern that she believes that someone is snooping around her flat at night. Sgt R advised her to phone 999 at the time it happens. James will notify Phil Brackley. PC Thompson will attend on Wednesday 17th November to advise re crime prevention.

Priorities Review

Anti-social behaviour

Op Shinewater was discussed with the Panel. In total 75 pedestrians were stopped by police and participating agencies. YDS spoke to approximately 60 young people in the area and provided details of various schemes across the town.

Two people were arrested and warned for possession of Cannabis

A Drugs warrant was conducted in the area and Class A drugs were seized. Occupants have been cautioned for possession.

Speeding vehicles in Shinewater

During Op Shinewater 15 Speeding tickets and several fixed penalty notices were given out for Driving while using a Mobile Phone and No Seatbelt.
